The records in the Murray County Recorder's Office can be viewed Monday-Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at 2500 28th Street, Slayton, Minnesota 56172.

Information Request

Recording is our first priority. Requests are processed in the order received and as we have time available. Staff will assist in obtaining copies of specific documents known, such as a plat map, book and page or document number, no matter the timeline. If you are looking for a tract search, please contact an Abstract and Title Company. The Murray County Recorder's Office does not abstract.

Laredo

This would be for daily or a professional user. Laredo is an Internet access program designed for abstract/title companies, title insurance firms and other real estate related business and need access daily to the land records in the county. Laredo is subscription based with 24 x 7 access. Fees are assessed to pay for support and maintenance of the system.
