1. Return **by mail** in the self-addressed stamped envelope provided. The ballot must be postmarked on or before Election Day.
2. Return **in person** by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day to:

Drop Box: A secure drop box is available at the north and south doors of the Murray County Government Center. Drop boxes are monitored by video security.

In-person Voting: A voting booth and AutoMARK assistive voting device are available at the Murray County Auditor-Treasurer's Office for voters who still wish to vote in person. **If choosing to vote this way it is very important that voters bring the official ballot, envelopes and materials mailed to them.**

Unregistered Voters in Mail Ballot Precincts: Eligible voters who have not registered by October 13, 2020 may still vote by absentee ballot.
