

## **NOTICE OF INFORMATIONAL MEETING REPLACEMENT OF THE LIME LAKE OUTLET DAM AND BRIDGE**

Murray County Parks hereby gives notice that an informational meeting will be held on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 2021, at the 4-H Community Building on the Murray County Fairgrounds, Slayton, Minnesota, from **6:00-6:50 PM**, regarding improvements to be completed on the outlet of Lime Lake. In case of inclement weather, listen to local radio stations for announcements.

Murray County Parks desires to replace the existing Lime Lake Outlet dam with a fish passable rock arch rapids. The project would also include replacement of the existing pedestrian bridge and potentially additional improvements to Murray County's Lime Lake Park. Water levels on the lake would be maintained. There is no intention to change the runout of the existing dam.
