Commissioner Gunnink introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS the flooding impacted the population of Murray County and its cities; and

WHEREAS the flooding event has caused a significant amount of public property damage; and

WHEREAS the Murray County Department of Emergency Management request the Murray County Board of Commissioners to declare Murray County in a STATE OF EMERGENCY for the flooding event of 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Murray County Board of Commissioners declared Murray County in a State of Emergency for conditions resulting from the flooding event of June 18, 2018 through June 21, 2018;
